4. ADD-ON IMPLEMENTATION

Batch Mode - example



An AdoScript can be specified on the arena command line. It is executed after the initialization of ADOxx is completed. The AdoScript is read from a file or from the standard input stream. In both cases the -e option has to be set, eventually together with a file name specification.

▶ Example 1

```
# Execute the AdoScript contained in startup.asc  
arena -uAdmin -ppassword -dado35 -sdb2 -estartup.asc
```

▶ Example 2

```
# Specifying an AdoScript via stdin  
echo CC "AdoScript" INFOBOX "Bonjour!" | arena -uAdmin -  
ppassword -dado35 -sdb2 -e
```
